Christmas at Christ Church

This year, on Sundays during Advent and Christmastide our minister has been presenting a series of sermons based on Mary's song of praise, the *Magnificat*, found in Luke 1:46-55. The series culminates this morning, on the Sunday of the Epiphany, which officially ends the Christmas Cycle:

Advent 1, Dec. 2--the Sunday of Hope;

Advent 2, Dec. 9--the Sunday of Peace;

Advent 3, Dec. 16--the Sunday of Joy;

Advent 4, Dec. 23--the Sunday of Love;

Sunday, Dec. 30--the Sunday in Christmastide;

Sunday, Jan.6, 2019--the Epiphany of the Lord.


