Worship Protocols

Though the wearing of face masks/coverings is optional in our worship service, we continue to ask that parishioners observe social distancing recommendations, do not congregate in the narthex or other public areas of the church before or after the service, and that you wait to be dismissed by pews by our ushers at the close of the service. For those who might be uncomfortable in gathering in public places amongst some who might not be wearing face masks/coverings, please know that our service is broadcast live on FM 96.7 to vehicles parked in our lot during the worship hour. Also, audio copies of each Sunday's sermon are posted weekly on our church website.

Please be reminded that our Sunday morning Bible studies

have resumed. They meet at 9:30 a.m. each Sunday. We invite you to join us. During this trial period, we ask that all participants practice social distancing as appropriate, and that all members of the classes (except the teacher) wear face masks for the duration of the class, unless called upon to speak, etc. Other small groups, including musical ensemble rehearsals, remain suspended until further notice.

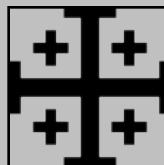
