Thank you for your gift to *Samaritan's Purse* for hurricane relief. We are truly grateful for your prayers and partnership as we assist people whose lives have been turned upside down. The devastation from hurricane Helene in western North Carolina and eastern Tennessee was unbelievable. It is the worst storm anyone in this region can remember and will require years of recovery. We flew 358 helicopter missions and used trucks for more than 200 ground missions to deliver critical supplies to isolated storm victims. Our disaster relief teams are continuing to work from multiple sites in this area and in Georgia to help families. We are also working in Florida to help families who were impacted by both hurricanes Helene and Milton. Please pray with us for those who are hurting. As we bring

relief in Jesus's name we want to share God's love and the hope of the gospel. *For God did not send his son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through him might be saved* (John 3:17). May God bless you,

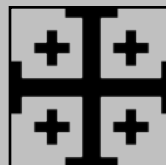
